The objective of these events is for the Fund's Board of Trustees to interact with the private security employers on issues that affect them and provide feedback on concerns raised during the 2013 Information Sharing Sessions.

Other issues that will be shared with the employers include:

- Changes in provident/pension fund legislation that has a direct effect on employers.
- Employers' obligation to its security employees on PSSPF contributions.
- The level of compliance in the sector.
- Legal prosecution of non-compliant companies.
- Initiatives employed by the fund in improving administration processes.

- Processes and payment of member claims and benefits.
- Issuing of certificates of good standing and exemption certificates.
- Streamlined process on the issuing of benefit statements.
- Various benefits offered by the fund to its members.
- Fund communication process to the employers and members.
- The role and contact details of the psspf national and regional offices.

Other stakeholders invited to participate in these information sessions are the Department of Labour and the Private Security Industry Regulatory Authority (PSIRA) to deal with employers' challenges with regards to the latter institutions.
